

## Rules and Regulations

1. Entry Fee - \$12 per class. No numbers will be issued without a signed blank check and signed entry form. A \$10 office fee will be charged to each entry except lead line. Faxed entries pay \$5.
2. Proper riding attire is required.
3. Proof of negative coggins within 12 months of show date.
4. All riders are required to wear approved headgear when they are mounted.  
Junior riders must wear ASTM approved helmets.
5. Classes may be cancelled or combined at the discretion of the management and show committee.
6. All entries will be judged on soundness upon entering the ring.
7. Four entry blanks must be completed to fill a performance class. Small and medium ponies will be separated if there are at least six in each section
8. All entry blanks must be completed and signed in accordance with Rule 5.
9. Championships will be awarded in all divisions: two of the four horses or ponies that have acquired the most points over fences and only those four horse or ponies will receive points in the under saddle.
10. Classes for Juniors are restricted to riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1, 2007.
11. Juniors may ride in 14-17 equitation and medal classes only once per weekend.
12. All ponies must have a current measurement card or be measured at the show.
13. The decisions of the judge will be final.
14. Stallions are barred from the show grounds.
15. All dogs brought to the show grounds are to be leashed at all times.
16. The BCHSA and the show committee of St. Timothy's School will assume no responsibility, is not liable for any injury to person or to any horse at any time, which includes going to, coming from and in the ring. Neither will it be responsible for vehicles or articles that may be lost or damaged. All owners and exhibitors will be held responsible for any damage incurred by them or their agent's properties on the show grounds.
17. The St. Timothy's School Horse Show is operated in accordance with the current rules of the Baltimore County Horse Show Association, Inc.

From the Beltway I-695, take Exit 22 North, Greenspring Ave. Go about 1.5 miles. The entrance to the school is on the left.

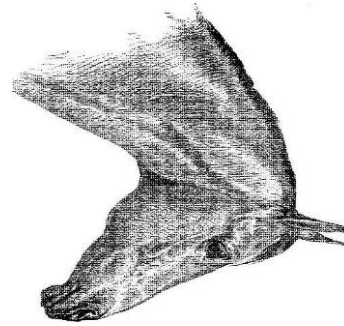

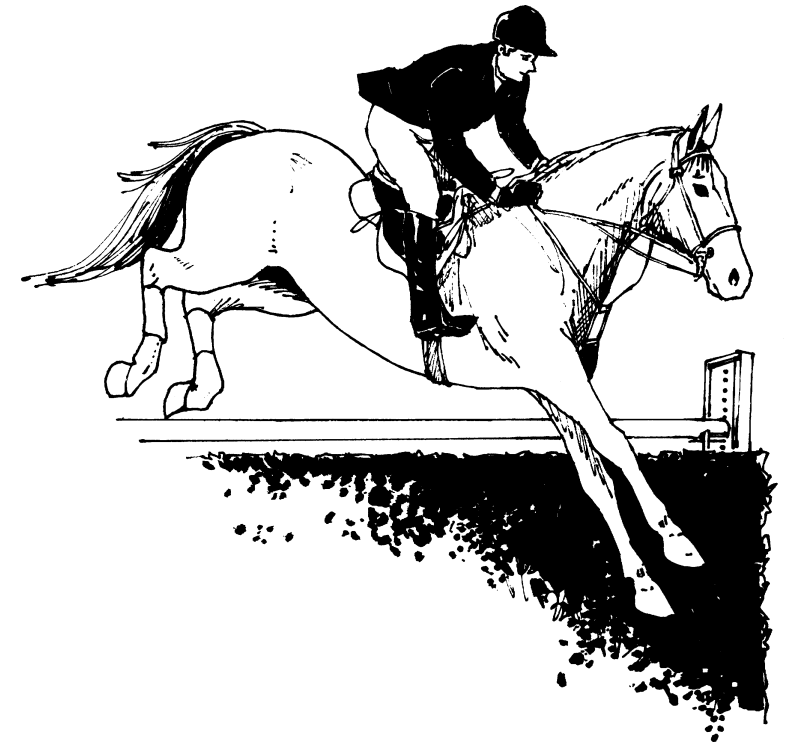
### Class Specifications

1. Points in all classes will be scored: First 10, Second 6, Third 4, Fourth 2, Fifth 1, Sixth ½.
2. Lead Line Division – Open to riders 7 year of age and under. Mounts not to exceed 14.2 hands. Riders in the class may not cross-enter in to any other division at the same show.
3. Mini Short Stirrup Division – Open to riders 10 years and under. Mounts not to exceed 14.2 hands. Riders in the division may not complete in any other division at the same show.
4. Short Stirrup Divisions – Open to riders 10 years and under. Mounts not to exceed 14.2 hands. A 50-50 division, riders in the division may not compete in any other division at the same show except short stirrup hunter. Jumps 18”.
5. Long Stirrup Divisions – Open to senior and junior riders over 10 yrs as of December 2007.
6. Medals – The rider must be a member of the Association to be shown over 8 fences. Horses or ponies must show in the same tack in all phases. Class to be judged on hands, seat, guidance, and control throughout.
7. Equitation 13 years and under – Open to riders who have not reached their 14th birthday. Fences 2’3” and 2’6” rider’s choice.
8. Equitation 14 to 17 years – Open to riders who have not reached their 14th birthday. Fences 2’6” and 3’ rider’s choice.
9. Adult Equitation – Open to riders 18 yrs and up, eligible to hold a USEF amateur card. Jumps 2’6”, 2’9” rider’s choice
10. Hunter Division - To be judged on performance, suitability, soundness, and manners.
11. Pony Divisions – Small ponies jump 2’3”. Medium ponies jump 2’6” Large ponies jump 2’9”. Low pony division: small/medium jump 2’, large jump 2’6”.
12. Horses: Jr. Hunters jump 3’. Open hunters jump 3’. Low hunters jump 2’6”. Green hunters jump first year 3’ while 2nd year jump 3’3”. Working hunters jump 3’6”. Adult amateur hunters- riders in this division must be eligible to hold an AHSA Amateur Card and jump 3’. Children’s and adult Amateur Low Hunters jump 2’6”.
13. Hopeful Hunter – Open to ponies and horses. Adults may rider ponies. Jumps 2’, 2’3” rider’s choice. A non-pointed division.
14. Pleasure divisions- To be judged on manners, suitability, and soundness. An entry may be judged for soundness on the pleasure circle. Martingales are prohibited. Ponies jump 2’. Horse jump 2’6”. Horse showing in this division may not compete in any divisions where fences are 3’ or higher, except equitation. Small pleasure ponies may not compete in any divisions where fences are 2’3” or higher, except equitation. Medium pleasure ponies may not compete in any divisions where fences are 2’6” or higher, except equitation. Large pleasure ponies showing in the division may not compete in any divisions where fences are 2’9” or higher, except equitation.
