St. James Academy

Take 695 East to 83 North, Take 83 North, Take Mount Carmel Road Exit. At the top of the exit ramp, turn right onto Mount Carmel Road. Follow Mount Carmel Road until it ends at York Road (approx. 1 mile from exit.), Turn right on York Road, Turn left on Monkton Road.(It’s the 1st left between 2 buildings and is almost immediately after you turn on York Ave.), Follow Monkton Road for several miles, pass over the Bike Path in the old town of Monkton. (Monkton Bike Shop is on your left.)- Once past the houses in old town, Monkton Road turns sharply right (at the intersection of Shepherd and Monkton roads.) Follow Monkton Road right at this turn.- The school is down Monkton road on the left. You will see the playground and the back of the school before you see the signs or the Church steeple. The driveway entrance to the school is after the church.

From Pennsylvania

I-83 South into Maryland to exit 27 (Mt Carmel Rd/ Hereford). Turn Left onto Mt. Carmel Rd. Follow Directions Above

Rules and Regulations

1. Participants in the St. James Academy Horse Show agree and acknowledge that "By entering this competition, and signing the entry form, the exhibitor agree to be subject to the BCHSA's rules, the prize list and the local rules of the competition.
2. This is a BCHSA and HHSAA Pointed Show and is operated in accordance with the current rules of the BCHSA and HHSAA. BCHSA rules take precedence.
3. **All entry forms must be signed by an adult before # will be given out. Junior rider entries must be signed by Parent or guardian.**
4. **A signed blank check made out to St. James must be left with secretary before # will be given out.**
5. All stallions are barred from the show grounds.
6. Proper riding attire is required. All riders are required to wear ASTM approved protective headgear at all times while mounted.
7. The Show management reserves the right to combine, divide or cancel classes and to change rings if necessary in the best interest of the show.
8. All entries must have proof of a negative coggins test dated within 12 months of the show date.
9. All ponies must have a measurement card.
10. The decision of the judges will be final.
11. **All dogs are barred from Show Grounds.**
12. A junior rider is a rider under 18 years of age as of December 1 of the previous year.
13. All entries will be judged on soundness upon entering the ring.
14. Cross Entering is permitted where eligible. Please read class descriptions.
15. Three entries are required to fill a performance class. Four entries are required for a BCHSA Medal Class; two entries are required for a HHSAA Medal Class.
16. **Schooling will be permitted from 6:30-7:45 AM – ring restrictions may be imposed to insure exhibitor safety at the discretion of show management, and show stewards. Schooling prior to 6:30 is at own risk.**
17. BCHSA, HHSAA, St. James Academy, St. James Church, and the show management will assume no responsibility for any accident or injury which may occur to any horse, exhibitor, equipment, or vehicle.
18. **EMT will be on the grounds at 7:00AM any schooling prior to this time is at own risk**
19. **Classes will not be held for coaching conflicts.**

Equitation Divisions

Pony Lead Line

Open To riders 7 years of age and under as of December 1 of the previous show year. Riders in this division may not cross enter into any other division. Mounts not to exceed 14.2 hands. Lead Line: to be shown on loose shank. Lead Line Walk: to be shown both ways of the ring at a walk.

Mini Short Stirrup

Open to riders 10 years of age and under as of December 1 of the previous show year. Mounts not to exceed 14.2 hands. Riders may not cross enter into any other divisions except the St. James Classic. Mini X-Rails to be shown over 4 fences at a trot or canter, riders choice. Fences: 12".

Short Stirrup

Open to riders 10 years or age and under as of December 1 of the previous show year. Mounts not to exceed 14.2 hands. Riders may not cross enter into any other division except short stirrup hunter and the St. James Classic. Fences: 18".

Long Stirrup

Open to riders 11 years of age and over as of December 1 of the previous show year. Riders may not cross enter into any other division except Long Stirrup Hunter and the St. James Classic. Fences: 18".

Novice Equitation

Open to all riders, juniors and Adults, who have not won more than 3 blue ribbons in any open equitation class (any class judged on the rider), excluding 4-H, Long Stirrup and Short Stirrup. Adults may ride ponies. To be judged on hands, seat and control of mount. Jumps 2' and 2'6", rider's choice.

Equitation 13 and Under

Open to riders 13 years of age and under as of December 1 of the previous show year. Fences: 2' 2'3" & 2'6", rider's choice.

Equitation 14 – 17

Open to riders who have reached their 14th birthday but not their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the previous show year. Fences 2'6" & 3', rider's choice.

Adult Equitation

Open to riders 18 years and older as of 12/1 of the previous year. To be judged on hands, seat and control of mount. Jumps at 2'6" and 3' For HHSAA and 2'6" and 2'9" for BCHSA, rider's choice.

BCHSA Junior Medal Horse/Ponies

Open to all Current BCHSA junior members – to be judged as an equitation class. The judges will then select at least 1/4 of the class, but not less than six (6) riders (if available) to show at a walk, trot, and canter. The same pony/horse must be shown in all phases of the class. Martingales are not permitted in the under saddle portion of the class. Pony Fences: 2', 2'3", 2'6", 2'9" Horse Fences 2'6", 3', rider's choice

Harford Hunt Seat Horse/Pony

Open to all current HHSAA junior members – to be judged as an equitation class. Shown over a course of 8 fences with at least one change of direction and Judge to select 8, if available, to show at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Pony Fences: 2', 2'3", 2'6", Horse Fences 3', rider's choice.

BCHSA Adult Medal

Open to all Current BCHSA senior members who are eligible to hold an AHSA Amateur card – to be judged as an equitation class. The judges will then select at least 1/4 of the class, but not less than six (6) riders (if available) to show at a walk, trot, and canter. The same pony/horse must be shown in all phases

of the class. Martingales are not permitted in the under saddle portion of the class. Fences: 2'6", & 3', rider's choice.

USET

Open to all HHSAA senior members who are eligible to hold an AHSA Amateur card – to be judged as an equitation class. Fences: 2'6", & 3', rider's choice.

St. James' Classic

Open to all current St. James' students only. It is not a pointed division. St. James students competing in the Mini Short Stirrup, Short Stirrup and Long Stirrup divisions may cross enter into the St. James Classic. Fences: 2' and 2'6".

Pleasure Divisions

Small/ Medium Pleasure Pony

Open to ponies 13.2 hands and under ridden by junior riders. Ponies showing in this division may not compete in any division where fences are 2'3" or higher for small ponies and 2'6" or higher for medium ponies, except equitation. No martingales. Fences: 2".

Large Pleasure Pony

Open to ponies over 13.2 hands but not exceeding 14.2 hands ridden by junior riders. Ponies showing in this division may not compete in any division where fences are 2'9" or higher, except equitation. No martingales. Fences: 2".

Pleasure Horse

Open to all horses over 14.2 hands. Horses showing in this division may not compete in any division where fences are 3' or higher, except equitation. No martingales. Fences 2'6".

Hunter Divisions

Short Stirrup Hunter

Open to riders 10 years of age and under as of December 1 of the previous show year. Mounts not to exceed 14.2 hands. Riders may not cross enter into any other division except Short Stirrup Equitation and St. James Classic. Fences: 2".

Long Stirrup Hunter

Open to riders 11 years of age and over as of December 1 of the previous show year. Riders may not cross enter into any other division except Long Stirrup Equitation and St. James Classic. Fences: 2"

Small/Medium Pony Hunter

Open to ponies 13.2 hands and under, not showing in Pleasure Pony. Ponies to be ridden by junior riders. Fences: Small ponies, 12.2 hands and under to jump fence height 2'3". Medium ponies over 12.2 hands but not exceeding 13.2 hands to jump fence height 2'6".

Large Pony Hunter

Open to ponies over 13.2 but not exceeding 14.2 hands, not showing in pleasure pony. Ponies to be ridden by a junior rider. Fences: 2'9".

Low Hunter

Open to horses over 14.2 hands. Fences: 2'6".

Low Small/Medium Pony Hunter

Open to ponies 13.2 hands and under. Ponies to be ridden by junior riders. Fences: 2".

Low Large Pony Hunter

Open to ponies over 13.2 hands but not exceeding 14.2 hands. Ponies to be ridden by a junior rider. Fences: 2'6".

Children's Hunter

Open to horses over 14.2 hands ridden by junior riders. Riders may not compete in any other division where fences exceed 2'9" except medal and equitation divisions. Fences: 2'6".

Prechildrens/Adult/Modified Hunter

Open to horses and ponies, to be ridden by Juniors and Amateurs only. Adults may ride ponies. Manners and suitability of a horse shall be emphasized in all classes; extreme speed shall be penalized. Suitability of a rider shall be determined by the height and weight of the rider as related to the size of the horse as well as the compatibility of the rider and horse. Judges may penalize but shall not eliminate an entry not having such manners and suitability. Fences to be approximately 2' to 2'3" in height Fences 2' Ponies, Horses 2'3"

Junior Hunter

Open to horses over 14.2 hands, except horses showing in pleasure horse – must be ridden by a junior rider.

Fences: 3'

Adult Amateur Low Hunter

Open to horses over 14.2 hands ridden by adult riders eligible to hold an AHSA Amateur card. Riders may not compete in any other division where fences exceed 2'9" except medal and equitation divisions. Fences: 2'6".

Adult Amateur Hunter

Open to horses over 14.2 hands, except horses showing in pleasure horse – must be ridden by an adult eligible to hold an AHSA Amateur card. Fences: 3'.

Baby Green Hunter

Open to horse over 14.2 hands of any age in its first year of showing over fences. May enter into any other division on that date so long as the jump heights do not exceed 2'6". A horse eligible for this division may go in the under saddle class only without breaking its pre-baby green status for the year. Baby green horses are not to gallop. Simple courses are suggested, and horses may trot their courses without being penalized. Fence heights 2'6". Not BCHSA Rated

HOPEFUL HUNTER

Open to horses and ponies. Adults may ride ponies. Manners and suitability of a horse shall be emphasized in all classes; extreme speed shall be penalized. Suitability of a rider shall be determined by the height and weight of the rider as related to the size of the horse as well as the compatibility of the rider and horse. Judges may penalize but shall not necessarily eliminate an entry not having such manners and suitability. – UNDER SADDLE- To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring; and stand quietly. To be judged on performance, manners and soundness. May be asked to hand gallop, but not more than eight (8) horses at a time. Martingales are prohibited OVER FENCES - To be shown in the ring or an outside course of approximately eight (8) fences. To be judged on performance, manners and suitability. Fences to be approximately 2' to 2'3" in height.

Green Hunter

Open to horses over 14.2 hands in their first or second year of showing in any classes that requires horses to jump 3' or higher. Horses showing in pleasure horse are not eligible. Fences: 3' first year, 3'3" second year.

Open Hunter

Open to horses over 14.2 hands, except horses showing in pleasure horse. Fences: 3'.

Working Hunter

Open to horses over 14.2 hands, except horses showing in pleasure horse. Fences 3'3"-3'6" **Not BCHSA Rate**
